Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Lynn Lopez at 6:31 PM.

Approve Agenda: Chris Helgeson made a motion to approve the agenda for the May 8, 2018 workshop. Amy Grove seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Board Business: Principal Dawn Bechtholdt requested approval from the board regarding two staff members who are teaching one section each out of their endorsement. Marchel Allenbaugh now has the correct endorsements for her subject area. This was not included on her current certificate, but it is currently. Brian Todd is currently teaching weight training (1 section) out of his endorsed area. Jen Knox made a motion to approve the two teachers each teaching one section out of their content. Chris Helgeson seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The board reviewed the proposed calendar for the 2018-2019 school year. Superintendent Dehuff shared that the calendar has two days built into the calendar as non-work days. These days are March 4th, and May 24th. If we should have any closures of Easton School because of weather and road conditions, these would be our “make up” days. If we don’t have any snow days, these would simply be non-work days. Chris Helgeson made a motion to approve the school calendar for 2018-2019 school year. John Jensen seconded the motion and the motion carried.


Superintendent Patrick Dehuff requested an amendment to the agenda to include an update regarding family meetings with students who are “out of district”. Dawn Bechtholdt shared that two days of family meetings have been held to date. Input is being gathered from parents and students who are “out of district”. Superintendent Dehuff is discussing student attendance, grades, and behavior expectations with the families. They both agreed that the input has been positive so far. Board Chair, Lynn Lopez asked about support for students who are going through difficult social and emotional issues. There is a Mental Health Counselor on campus weekly to counsel with and help students. Dawn shared that the staff have had training for suicide prevention and Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) and PBIS/Restorative Practice. All staff have been invited to an eight hour Mental Health First Aid Training on June 14th. John Jensen suggested a fundraising option for the archers to help with parking cars during the Memorial Day


Parade.
