Board member Phillip Meehan made a motion to select Tim Berndt as Interim Superintendent/Principal. Board member John Jensen seconded the motion.

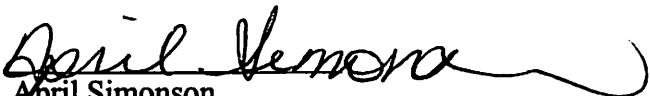
Board president April Simonson asked for any discussion on the motion. There being none, the board president asked for a roll-call vote on the motion.
