- 1) Future Plans, Objective(s) and Goals: List the academic programs or majors that interest you and why.
- 2) Service Activities, Awards / Honors, Extracurricular Activities, and Employment History: (List all employers, positions held, and dates of employment) Describe your participation, role, and accomplishments and **let us know what you did that impacted you most!**
- 3) Transcript: Attach a copy of your current high school transcript.
- 4) Letter of Recommendation: Include one letter of recommendation from someone who is not a relative.
- 6) Required Essay: *Consider the importance of tax supported institutions in the day-to-day life of your community. Please choose a local public institution like the city hall, medical clinic, library, fire department, forest service, etc. or a non profit with a local presence such as HopeSource, Mountains to Sound Greenway Trust, or the Nature Conservancy and write an informative essay. Each has a history, a mission or mission statement, and structure with staff that make it possible to function so do include those elements.*

*Note: Do not write about school and do not write about somewhere your relatives work. (This is a small town!) **This is an opportunity to learn about your community and open your eyes to potential careers right here.** The above list is just a fraction of possible topics, but please remember no private businesses.*

Tips: Lucky you to live in the internet age! This information is easily available online. To really tackle this properly though, consider crafting an email to request a telephone interview; people love to talk about their professions and help students.
